<p><u>Whitmoor Common Car Park, Salt Box Road 12/12/23</u></p> <p><u>Hare : Pusseye</u></p> <p><i>I was up in Rugby visiting family so missed the WH3 Christmas bash but I gather the WH3 area had had as much rain over the weekend as I had experienced further north. In addition it had rained heavily Monday and most of Tuesday. Knowing Whitmoor common reasonably well I know it can be very soggy area at the best of times. However, even I was unprepared for a flooded road on the way to the on out or the lake at the entrance to the carpark. It did not bode well.....</i></p> <p><i>By eight o'clock 13 hashers had assembled which, with the hare made a total of 14 so at least one potential bit of bad luck had been avoided.</i></p> <p><i>The brave hashes assembled were Machinist, Master Bates, Wasser, Tosser, Agent provocateur, Naked Chef, Top Man, Tight Git, Pig Pen, Megabit, Kebab, plus Kung Foo Panda and Wurzel plus the hare Pusseye.</i></p> <p><i>Before the off Pusseye briefed us promising a combined Food and Drink stop and handing out a map showing a short cut that she promised led straight to the stop.</i></p> <p><i>A small group, who shall remain nameless, immediately set off on the short cut while the rest of us, just over half the pack set off on the main trail.</i></p> <p><i>Initially running roughly parallel to Saltbox road the trail seemed reasonably dry but after a check on the railway bridge the first bit of shiggy was encountered. This was only a short stretch but was a portent of what was to follow. A run along the tarmac pavement of the A320 was followed by a check by a check by a lake at the junction of the A320 and Saltbox road. The hare warned us about inconsiderate care drivers who seemed to find it funny to soak pedestrians. What she didn't warn us about was the next section of the trail.....</i></p> <p><i>This continued along "footpaths" or streams through Stringers Marsh, (apparently known</i></p>			

locally as Stringers Common) until we emerged on dryland in the Bellfields estate. A trot round the estate in the dry was followed by a rare, for Weybridge hash, back check that led us back over the railway and a further dry blacktop section and to the promised Food and Drink stop.

This was ably overseen by the temporally named Drummer John and despite the worries of the main part of the pack that the short cutters would have devoured all the victuals the magnificent spread was so generous that even after the attentions of the main pack there was still surplus. Also provided was mulled wine, which once it was cooled from the superheated temperature it was initially served at was found to be very palatable.....

Having indulged in food and drink I anticipated that the trail would be short and incident free. The hare had other ideas as she led us along tarmac through Queen Elizabeth park to cross Worplesdon Road and into the boardwalks of Chitty's Common. The boardwalks had been covered in metal mesh, presumably as a safety measure to provide grip but this seemed to be a case of theory and reality being out of alignment. The wet made the mesh extremely slippery and wear left "bald" patches and in other areas protruding wires producing hazards that reduced the hash to a slow shuffle rather than a fast run.

Emerging back onto Worplesdon Road a short stretch on tarmac and a last shiggy covered back passage brought the pack back to the large lake at the entrance to the car park and those who had short cut.

The On Inn at Worplesdon Place proved to be the last test for many of the pack, with many investigating falsies off the two checks (otherwise known as roundabouts) on route to the pub.

Many thanks to Pusseye for a very enjoyable and challenging trail and for putting on a magnificent spread of food and drink (although it was noted that there was an absence of chips in the pub..... 😊)
